**BOARD APPROVED A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE 2025-2026 POLICE BUDGET TO ADDRESS A POLICE TRAFFIC SAFETY GRANT.**

Trustee Jones moved to approve a Resolution amending the 2025-2026 Police budget to address a Police Traffic Safety Grant in the amount of \$1,761.68.

Seconded by Trustee Genesky and adopted by a full vote in the affirmative.

**BOARD APPROVED THE HIRE OF A SEASONAL EMPLOYEE FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS.**

Trustee Genesky moved to approve the hire of Joseph Rizzo as a seasonal employee for the Department of Public Works, effective December 15, 2025.

Seconded by Trustee Jones and adopted by a full vote in the affirmative.

**BOARD APPROVED THE APPOINTMENT OF A MEMBER TO THE EXAMINING BOARD OF PLUMBERS.**

Trustee Ring moved to approve the appointment of John Dollendorf to the Examining Board of Plumbers for a (3) three-year term, to expire December 2028.

Seconded by Trustee Catalano and adopted by a full vote in the affirmative.

**BOARD APPROVED A NEGATIVE DECLARATION REGARDING VICTORIA PLACE/ST. PAUL'S SCHOOL PUD PROJECT.**

Trustee Catalano moved to approve a Negative Declaration finding no significant adverse environmental impact regarding the conversion of the former St. Paul's School to senior housing at 39 and 45 Victoria Boulevard. This project is referred to as the Victoria Place Planned Unit Development (PUD) project.

Seconded by Trustee Ring and adopted by a full vote in the affirmative.

**BOARD APPROVED A REOLUTION ESTABLISHING THE PUD PLAN FOR THE VICTORIA PLACE PLANNED UNIT DEVELOPMENT PROJECT.**

Trustee Jones moved to approve the final plan for the Victoria Place Planned Unit Development (PUD) at 39 and 45 Victoria Boulevard.

Seconded by Trustee Genesky and adopted by a full vote in the affirmative.
